- Completion of Monthly Projects and Assignments
- Completion of the Semester Project Assigned.

**Taking the Next Step:**

Interested students should:

1. Complete Attached Application and return with photo and \$75 deposit.
2. Once application and letters of recommendation are received, our office will contact the applicant to schedule a phone interview.
3. After all the aforementioned items are received in our office (application, photo, letters of recommendation, deposit and phone interview conducted), an official Letter of Acceptance will be sent to the student.
4. A detailed course description will be included with the Letter of Acceptance. This course description will include weekly reading schedule and project assignments and textbooks to be purchased.
